

About eProcurement MMP Portal

Government of India has been envisaging early and fast adoption of the eProcurement, in different Government departments due to the perceived gains of transparency, cost efficiency, shorter procurement cycle etc. with the electronic mode of Government procurement/ tendering process. This is planned to be achieved through the Mission Mode Project (MMP) for electronic Government Procurement under National eGovernance Plan (NeGP), being pursued by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Commerce, with the support from the Department of Information Technology. It has been decided by the Standing Finance Committee that Government eProcurement Solution of National Informatics Centre (GePNIC) would be used as National eProcurement Portal for rollout in 23 States and UTs in a phase of two years. National Informatics Centre (NIC) has been given the responsibility for setting up this common portal for dissemination of Information..

The primary objective of the portal is to provide a single point access to the information on procurements made across various State Government Departments, Directorates, Statutory Organisations, Local bodies, Undertakings / Boards in their respective States.
