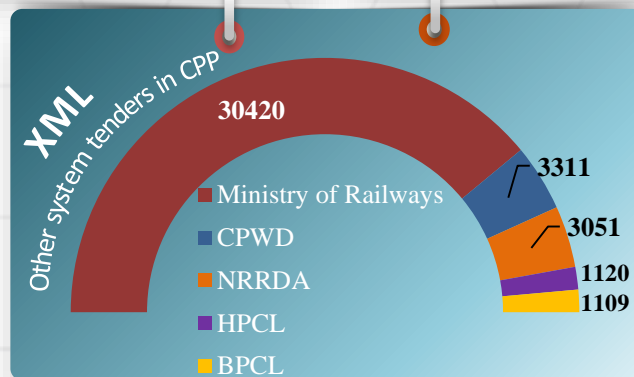
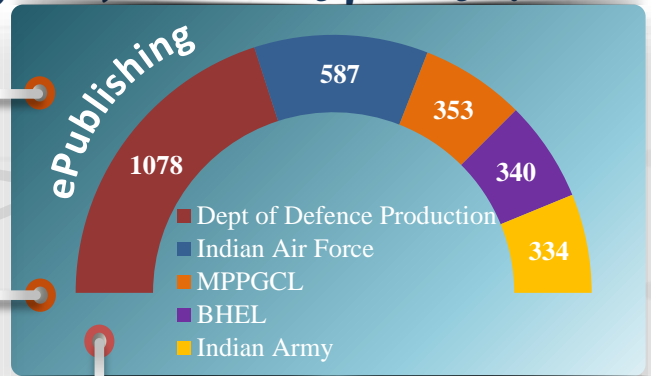
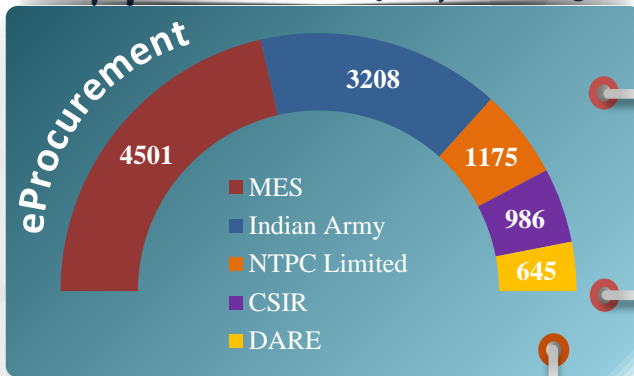

It facilitates ePublishing – Publishing of tender enquiries & award details. Bids are invited offline, XML – Facilitates publishing of tender information of other system and eProcurement which is facilitated through - Government eProcurement System of NIC, GePNIC©. 28 States and Union Territories across the country are also using GePNIC

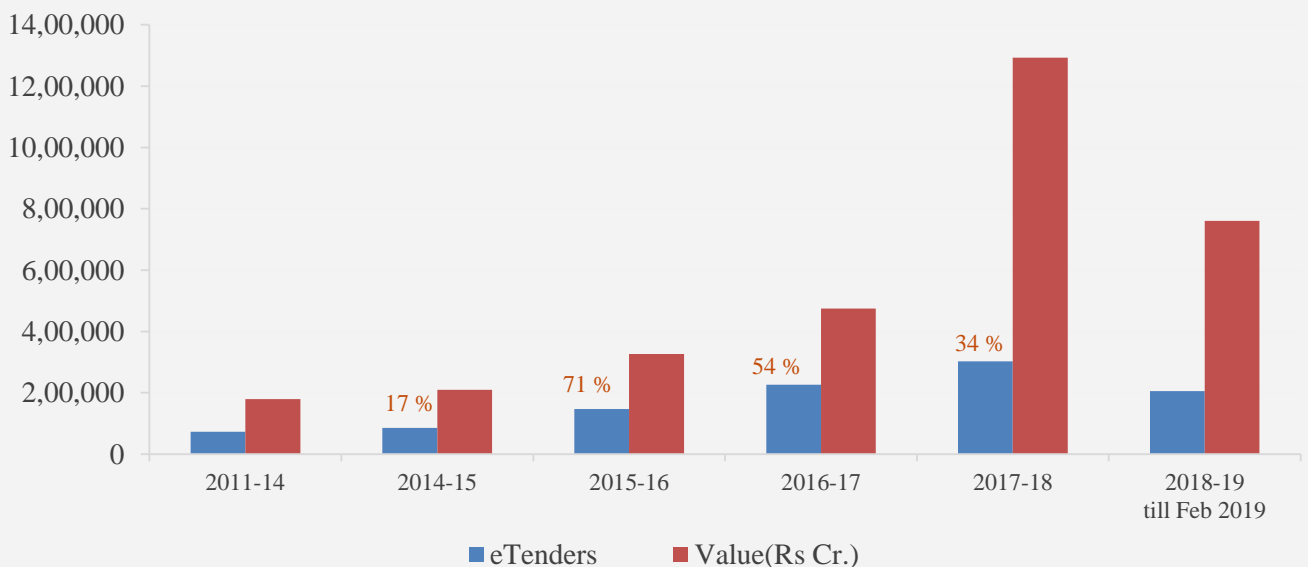

Important Tips Related to GFR 2017

What do I do if there is only single bid is received in a tender ?

- *Even if a tender results in single bid a procuring entity can go ahead for evaluating the same as per **Rule 173 of GFR 2017***
Even when only one Bid is submitted, the process may be considered valid provided following conditions are satisfied:
 - a. the procurement was satisfactorily advertised and sufficient time was given for submission of bids.*
 - b. the qualification criteria were not unduly restrictive; and*
 - c. prices are reasonable in comparison to market values*

CPPP Performance over the year



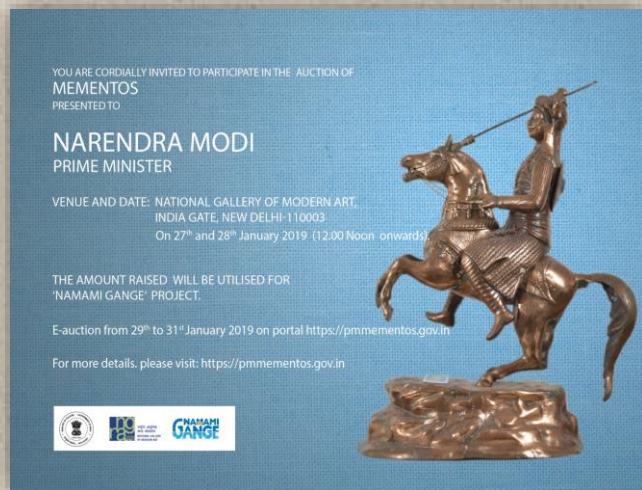
% Depicted indicates increase in no. of tenders over the previous year

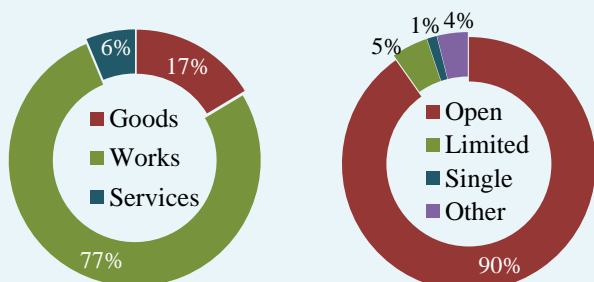
The auction received over whelming online response and was extended many times.

Over all Statistics of GePNIC, since Inception – Category wise and Tender type wise

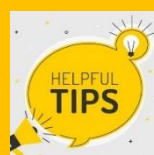


Highlights

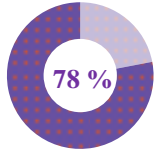
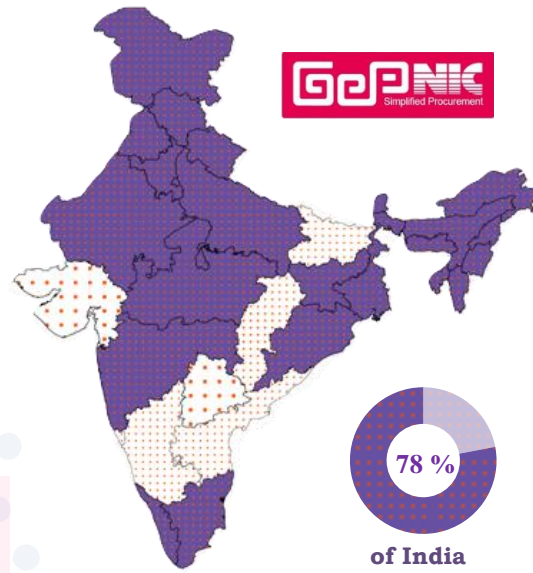
