


# CPPP NEWSLETTER

**Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP)** of Government of India is operational since 2012. It provides a single point access to all the tendering information on various procurements made across all central government organizations in the country. It facilitates :

- **ePublishing** – Publishing of tender enquiries, corrigendum & award of contract details.
- **XML** – Facilitates publishing of tender comprehensive information of other eProcurement system
- **eProcurement** facilitated through – GePNIC© implemented in 450 Central Government Ministries/ Departments and Public Sector Units, it is also being rolled out across India in 28 State Govts /UTs.



*% Depicted indicates increase in no. of tenders over the previous year*






||| No. of Tenders - Year Wise




||| Average Days to Evaluate Technical Bids - Year wise



||| Average Days Between Opening of Technical Bids and financial Bid in 2 Packet System - Year Wise





||| Average Days Taken to Evaluate Financial Bids - Year Wise

# Important Information Related to GFR 2017

## Rule 168 of GFR 2017

### Contents of Bidding Document

All the terms, conditions, stipulations and information to be incorporated in the bidding document are to be shown in the appropriate chapters as below :-

- Chapter – 1: Instructions to Bidders.
- Chapter – 2: Conditions of Contract.
- Chapter – 3: Schedule of Requirements.
- Chapter – 4: Specifications and allied Technical Details.
- Chapter – 5: Price Schedule (to be utilised by the bidders for quoting their prices).
- Chapter – 6: Contract Form.
- Chapter – 7: Other Standard Forms, if any, to be utilised by the purchaser and the bidders.

### Highlight of the Month

World Bank, under the aegis of 'Lighthouse India', organized a PFM Round Table on May 9 and 10, 2019 in New Delhi.

It was attended by 8 states and representatives from the DEA, C&AG, CGA, NIC, GeM, IMF, ADB and the World Bank. This was the first in a series of 'deep dive' technical sessions whose objective was to understand 'how' states were implementing PFM reforms in three areas namely - i) ) Discontinuation of Letter of Credit for Works Department & Submission of accounts and vouchers to the AG in the electronic form; ii) E-procurement; and iii) Budget Transparency and Accountability.

NIC was invited to present the extent of operationalization of e-procurement systems in states with an emphasis on online Payment , automatic refund & Interface with FMIS In context of GePNIC


