

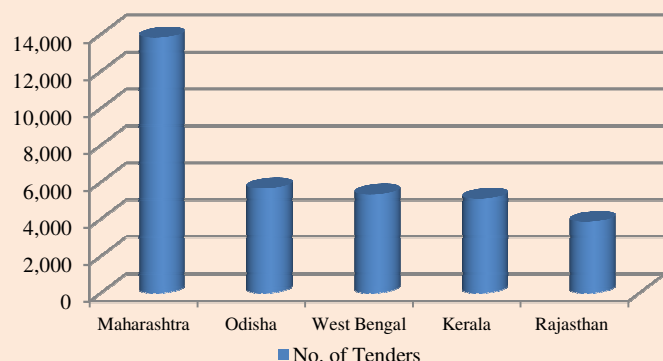
Introduction of the Product

National Informatics Centre (NIC), Ministry of Information Technology, Government of India has developed eProcurement software system, GePNIC to cater to the electronic procurement/ tendering requirements of the Government departments and organizations. The system is generic in nature and can easily be adopted for all kinds of procurement activities such as Goods, Services & Works, by Government offices.

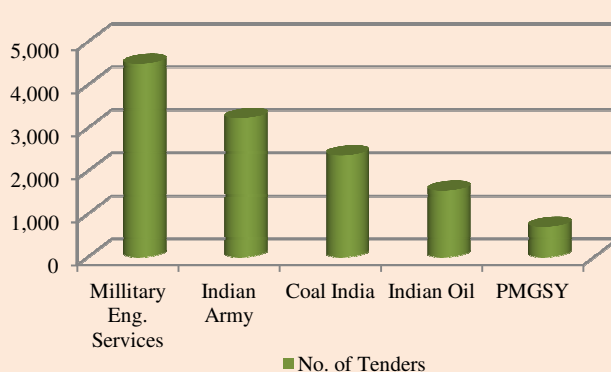
It is being implemented in 27 States and Union Territories as Mission Mode Project (MMP), Various Major Public Sector Units (PSU's) as well as over 200 Central Government Ministries / Departments / PSUs / Attached offices / Statutory Bodies etc. under the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPPP).

During the month of **November 2016** around **62,171** tenders were processed electronically worth **Rs 86,011.66 Cr.**

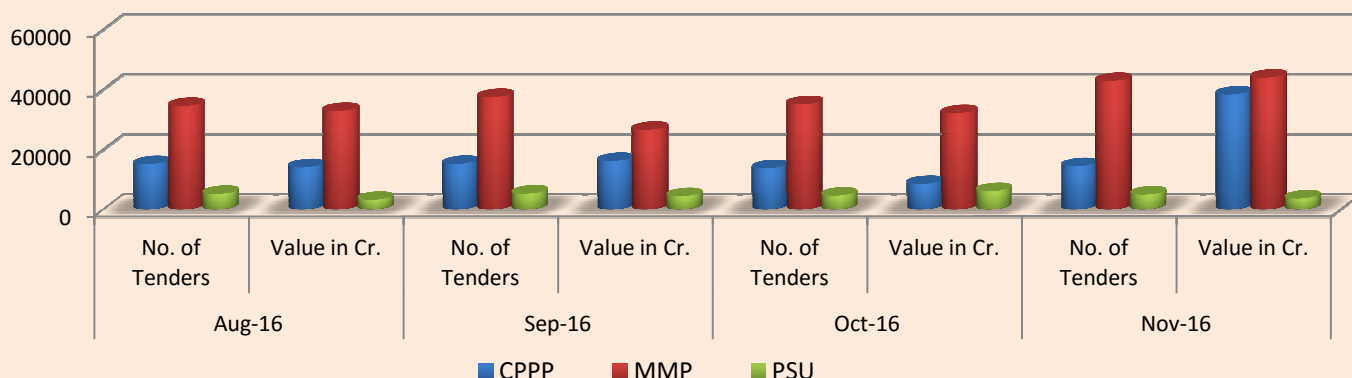
Top Five Performing States/ UT's during this month



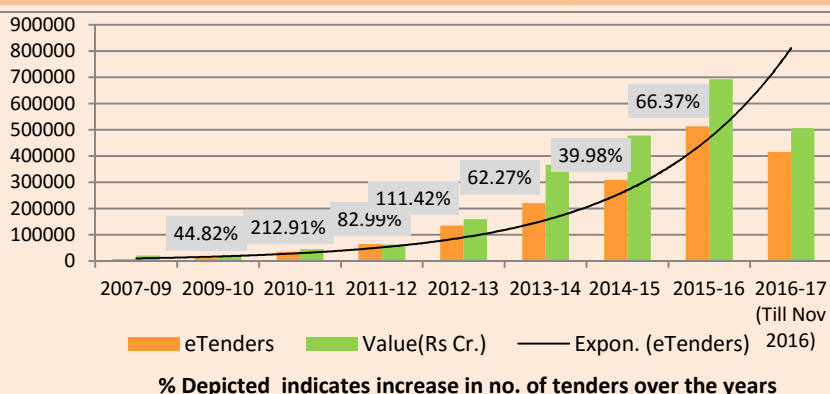
Top Five Central Govt. Entities during this Month



Comparative Growth of CPPP, MMP, PSU's/ Others



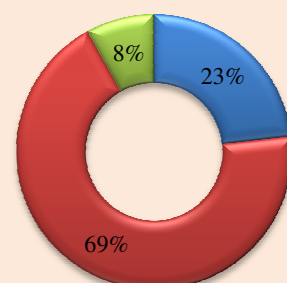
Yearly Growth since Inception

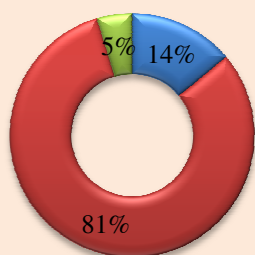

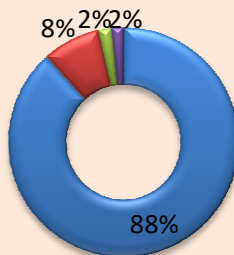
Category wise No. of Tenders

Salient Feature

NIC eProcurement system has been designed taking into account best tendering practices followed in the country including World Bank and Asian Development Bank guidelines. It adheres to GFR 2005, CVC Guidelines, IT Act 2000 & its amendment. It is also certified by STQC for “Guidelines for compliance to Quality and Security requirements of e-Procurement Systems” as mandated Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology.

The system can be configured for use by an organization at its apex level, and at multiple subordinate levels, at which tenders could independently be floated. NIC has hosted 40 live instance of the single product.

Major Workshop during the month

- Workshop at **NIC Mizoram** - Chief Secretary to Govt. of Mizoram and various other secretaries participated along with 50-60 official participants. Overview of the system, Live demonstration, Best Practices, Road Ahead were covered. The workshop was held on 17th and 18th November 2016.
