
Introduction of the Product

National Informatics Centre (NIC), Ministry of Information Technology, Government of India has developed its own eProcurement software system, GePNIC to cater to the electronic procurement/ tendering requirements of the Government departments and organizations. The system is generic in nature and can easily be adopted for all kinds of procurement activities such as Goods, Services & Works, by Government offices.

It is being implemented in 27 States and Union Territories as Mission Mode Project (MMP) as well as over 200 Central Government Ministries / Departments / PSUs / Attached offices / Statutory Bodies etc under the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP). Various Major Public Sector Units (PSU) are also using GePNIC for a long time as separate instance.

During the month of October 2016 around 53,415 tenders were processed electronically worth Rs 46,743.31 Cr.

Top Five Performing States/ UT's during this month




Top Five Central Govt. Entities during this Month




% Share of Tenders Processed

Yearly Growth since Inception





Salient Feature

NIC eProcurement system has been designed taking into account best tendering practices followed in the country including World Bank and Asian Development Bank guidelines. It adheres to GFR 2005, CVC Guidelines, IT Act 2000 & its amendment. It is also certified by STQC for "Guidelines for compliance to Quality and Security requirements of e-Procurement Systems" as mandated Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology.

The system can be configured for use by an organization at its apex level, and at multiple subordinate levels, at which tenders could independently be floated. NIC has hosted 40 live instance of the single product.

Post Tendering Workshop

In an attempt to bring in end to end eProcurement in GePNIC as mandated by the Expenditure Management Committee and Department of Expenditure, Min if Finance NIC has developed a prototype of the proposed system. The system will help user Organisations floating and processing Works Tenders to manage their contracts, Post Award.

In the workshop held on 19th Oct 2016 at National Informatics Centre, Head Quarters, New Delhi the beta version (prototype) was demonstrated to select officials of organisations using works tenders widely in their day to day procurement.

Officers from Delhi Development Authority, Defence Research & Development Organisation (Civil Works & Estates), National Hydro Power Corporation attended the same. Officers from eProcurement team at NIC Chennai demonstrated the flow.
