

# Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP)

Central Public Procurement Portal is operational since 2012. It hosts the Government eProcurement System (GePNIC<sup>®</sup>) for electronic procurement developed by National Informatics Centre in close coordination with Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance. CPPP provides a single point access to all the information tendering various on procurement made across the country. It is integrated with Government eMarketplace and is called as GeM-CPPP.

# It facilitates

**ePublishing:** Publishing of tender enquiries, corrigendum & award of contract details.

**XML:** Facilitates publishing the metadata of tenders published by organisations using varied eProcurement System.

**GeM Bids:** All the bids published on Government eMarket Place is also shown here.

eProcurement: Complete gamut of Procurement Goods, Works and Services including Global Tenders, Pre-Post integrations and is implemented in around 800+ Central Government Ministries / Departments and Public Sector Units, it is also used in 31 State Government/Union Territories for online tendering. Many World Bank and ADB tenders are processed using this GePNIC<sup>®</sup> platform.

## Airports Authority of India (AAI)

The Airports Authority of India (AAI) has been a premier user of the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) since January 2017. Between January 2017 and February 2025, AAI issued 27,707 tenders, with a total contract value of ₹95,814.27 crores. During this period, a total of 1,01,624 bids were received.

2022 recorded the highest award percentage at 57%, while 2023 saw the highest tender value of ₹18,933.13 crores. AAI has maintained a steady tendering process on CPPP, with a substantial number of awards each year.

## Major Projects during last Lustrum of AAI



AAI sought an Independent Facade Consultant for quality audit and vetting of facade systems during terminal building construction at Chennai Airport. Tender was published on January 29, 2020.



#### 🖄 New Delhi and Bagdogra

AAI issued a tender for architectural and engineering consultancy services in New Delhi and Bagdogra. Released on April 4, 2022, the project includes design, planning, construction supervision, and stakeholder coordination, focusing on modernization and expansion, including a new civil enclave at Bagdogra Airport.





AAI launched Phase-II of Ayodhya Airport's development project for a new terminal, ancillary buildings, parking, and city-side development. The terminal has accommodate 3,200 peak-hour passengers, reflecting temple architecture. The tender was issued on October 12, 2023. Completion is expected in three years, enhancing regional connectivity.



AAI initiated a project for a new terminal at Varanasi Airport under the EPC model. The terminal, spanning 75,220 sqm, will handle 6 million passengers annually with modern facilities. The project is expected to be completed by July 2027.
