About CENTRAL PUBLIC PROCUREMENT PORTAL

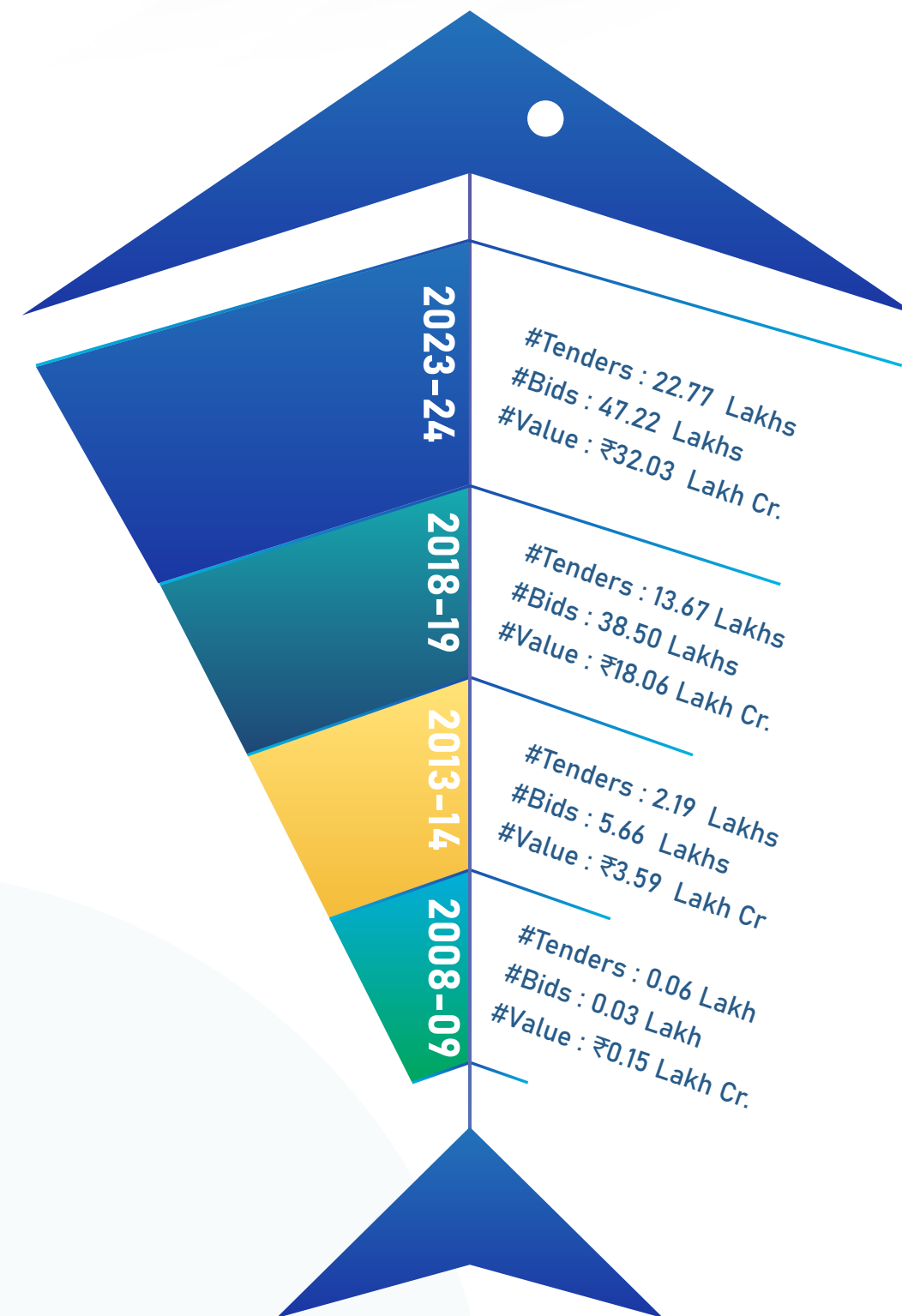
In pursuance of the recommendations of the Committee on Public Procurement headed by Shri Vinod Dhall and the decisions thereon of the Group of Ministers constituted to consider measures to tackle corruption and ensure transparency, the Department of Expenditure has taken action for setting up a Central Public Procurement Portal (CPP Portal in 2012). National Informatics Centre (NIC) has been given the responsibility for setting up this portal. The primary objective of the portal is to provide a single point access to all the information on procurements made across various Ministries and the line Departments.

Tender information from all State/Union Territories, Central Government entities, Central Public Sector undertakings and Government eMarket Place are made available on a real time basis. The CPP Portal is accessible at the URL <http://eprocure.gov.in> and it has e-publishing and e-procurement modules. Active tenders, Corrigendum, Bid Awards, across States/UTs, Central Government, CPSEs, Vendor Debarment information, Global tenders, High value tenders, Grievance/Suggestion capture, Monthly Newsletters, Annual Reports, Capacity building programme schedule, are made available.

BACKGROUND

National Informatics Centre (NIC), Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, after having developed a generic software “Government eProcurement system of NIC (GePNIC®) has” in close association with Procurement Policy Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance developed, hosted and implemented the Central Public Procurement Portal customized to cater to the electronic procurement/ tendering requirements of the Central Government departments and other organizations.

The system is made available as a platform and can easily be adopted for all kinds of procurement such as Goods, Services & Works. It aims at transparency and non-discrimination amongst bidders, by allowing free access to tender documents,

clarifications, secure online bid submission and access to bid opening event to all, from any place on 24x7 basis, using the system through Internet, in a faster, and secure environment adopting industry standard open technologies. Variety of procurement requirements of varied procuring entities has been built in a robust configurable , workflow-based manner.

This can be configured for use by an organization at its apex level, and at multiple subordinate levels, at which tenders could independently be floated. Strong in-built security features including two factor Authentication with Digital Signature Certificates (DSCs) for foreign nationals also as per IT Act, Usage of SSL, Role-based User Access and Bid encryption at Client end, using PKI technologies.

The Central Public Procurement Portal catering a platform has brought in transparency and reliability in procurement process. Through this document the provided information will provide insight of features and security of CPP Portal.

Where the bid will not get tampered by any means possible, bidding document will be available with the respective vendor in tenders, RTI vigilance will get minimized and this portal also promotes open competition with free registration for bidders.

Lessons Learnt & Challenges Addressed

Policy

No uniform central legal framework governing public procurement processes across the country. While a few States have enacted their respective Transparency in Public Procurement Acts, procurement activities at large continue to be regulated through executive directives and departmental guidelines.

A significant challenge has been the formulation of a standardized and generic framework to facilitate the implementation of electronic tendering systems, considering the wide variation in procurement processes, procedures, and documentation formats adopted by different Government Ministries, Departments, and Agencies.

Process

The ownership and implementation of the e-Procurement system within an organization shall rest with the procurement function, with appropriate technical support from the IT division. It has been observed that, in several instances, the responsibility for implementation was entrusted to IT personnel who had limited familiarity with procurement procedures and processes.

To address such situations, the National Informatics Centre (NIC) has extended comprehensive technical support and continuous handholding to ensure effective adoption and operationalization of the e-Procurement system across departments and organizations.

Leadership and Governance

It has been seen that thrust from the top leadership accelerate the implementation & adoption. Leaders establish clear vision & direction in align with the organization goal understanding the shortcomings and keeping in minds the forthcoming issues. This increases productivities and efficiency, simplifies

decision making which contributes to better results.

On the other hand, organization which lacks top leadership support generally moves forward at a very slow case. The National Informatics Centre (NIC) has provided continuous support and handholding to facilitate this transition and to strengthen institutional capacity for effective use of the electronic procurement system.

Capacity Building (People)

As we move across the IT awareness and technology adoption also varied from place to place. A plethora of our bidder community in the far flanged areas of the country did not possess necessary IT skills and knowledge. Extensive capacity building measures like PMUs, Help desk, email support have enabled fade this divide over a period of time.

Technology and Tools

Ensuring robust technological infrastructure and digital tools has been a key enabler in the successful implementation of e-Procurement systems across Government organizations. The easy availability of Digital Signature Certificates (DSCs) and related tools facilitated issuance of DSCs nationwide including foreign nationals. A bidder/Contractor of foreign origin can now get a DSC online.

Other major enhancement are for Example -The Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) revised the Encryption Policy storage by through escrow account.

Upgraded IT infrastructure, improved connectivity, secure authentication mechanisms, and stronger encryption standards have collectively enhanced system reliability and user confidence. These advancements have fostered uniform adoption and ensured a secure, resilient, and technology-driven procurement environment across the Government of India.

Central Public Procurement Portal

Assimilation of all tenders across the country

The Central Public Procurement Portal serves as a one-stop platform for accessing all activities related to Government of India policies, standards, guidelines, orders, and other instructions on public procurement.

It is mandatory for all Ministries, Departments, their attached and subordinate offices, Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), and autonomous/statutory bodies to publish their tender notices and enquiries on the Central Public Procurement Portal.

JOURNEY SO FAR

The Central Public Procurement Portal was made operational on 1st January 2012, following a two-phased implementation model designed to progressively bring all Central Government entities within the ambit of electronic procurement—comprising the e-Publishing phase and the e-Procurement phase.

The GePNIC® system has demonstrated exceptional growth in scale, outreach, and adoption over the past decade. From 54,427 tenders valued at ₹43,700

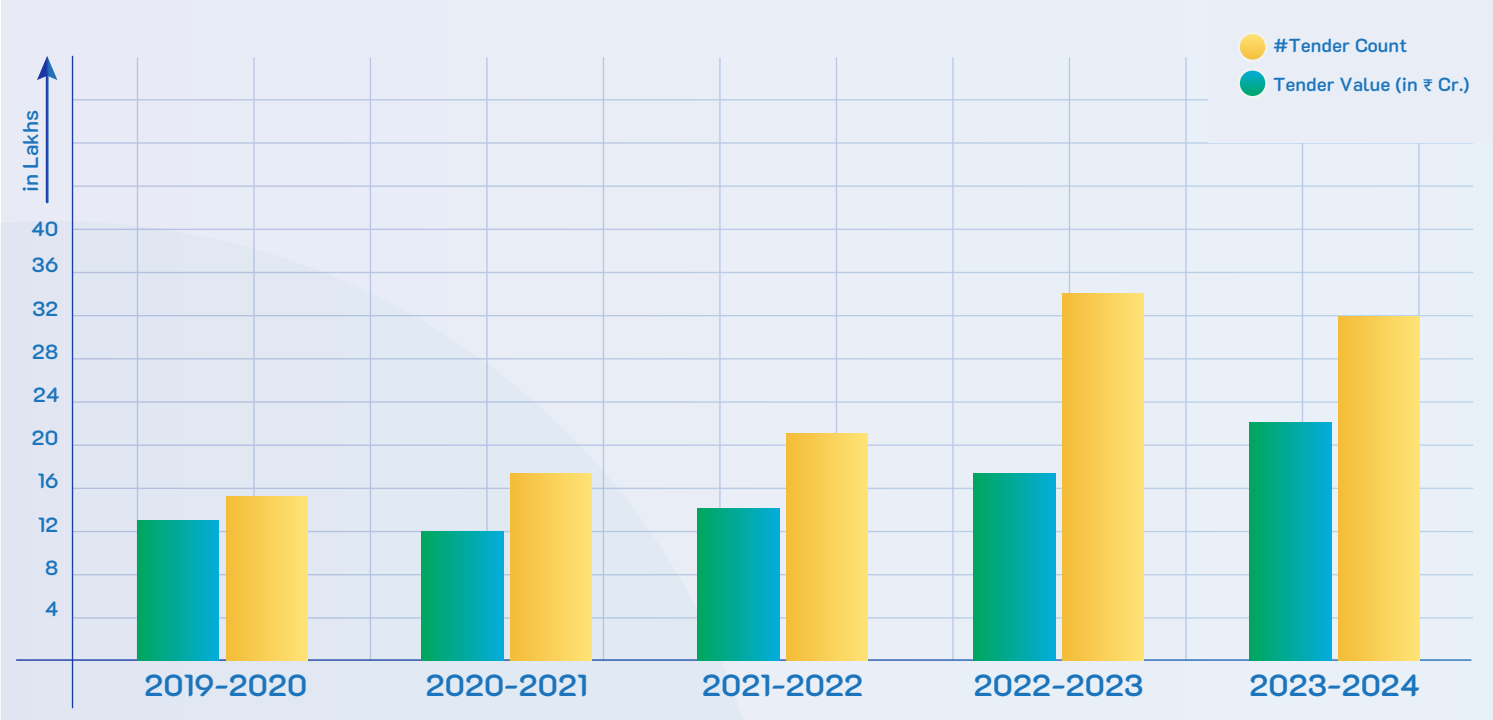


Crores in 2011–2012, the system expanded by over 100% in the subsequent year, processing 1,12,957 tenders worth ₹1,17,223 Crores in 2012–2013. This upward trajectory continued in 2013–2014, with 1,80,362 tenders amounting to ₹2,49,135 Crores, marking a nearly fourfold increase in tender value within three years.

By 2023–2024, the platform had achieved unprecedented growth, processing 22,77,029 tenders with an aggregate value exceeding ₹32,02,875 Crores. This represents a more than 40-fold increase in tender count and an over 70-fold rise in tender value since 2011–2012. The Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP), through its GePNIC® platform, has thus emerged as a cornerstone of digital governance—transforming public procurement across India by enhancing transparency, efficiency, accountability, and ease of doing business for all stakeholders.

By issuing various guidelines and with constant monitoring, Procurement Policy Division, Department of Expenditure has successfully on boarded majority of Central government procuring entities on to the portal. Multiple channels of Capacity Building, Easy availability of Digital Signature Certificates, Process re engineering as per need, inculcating the adoption of Best Practises across organisation, availability of uniform platform for ease of use and quick adoption in case of interdepartmental transfers etc were the steps taken which resulted in multifold increase growth over the last few years across the country.

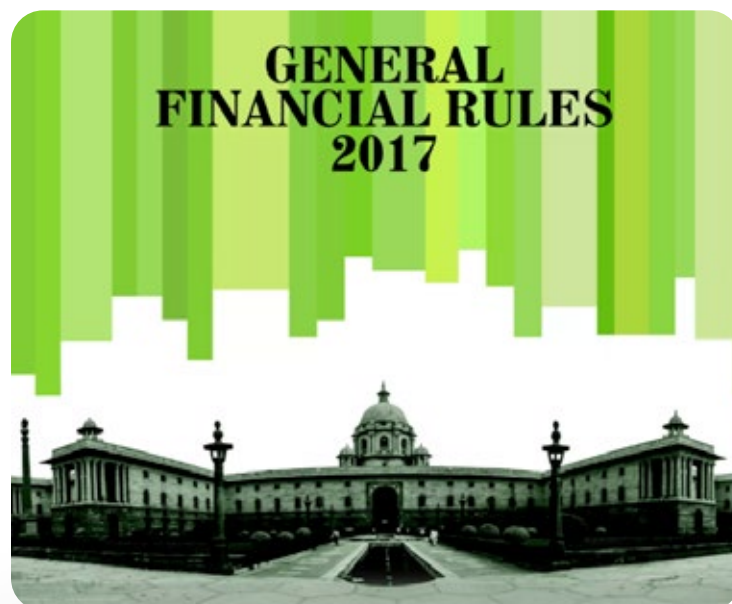

Central Public Procurement Portal

As per Government Finance Rules (GFR 2017)

The Transparency Principle which is one of the fundamental principles of public procurement as per General Financial Rules, 2017 (Rule 144) states that 'all procuring entities should ensure that offers should be invited following a fair and transparent procedure and also ensure publication of all relevant information on the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP).

Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) has been designed, developed and hosted by National Informatics Centre (NIC, Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology) in association with Dept. of Expenditure to ensure transparency in the public procurement process. The primary objective of the Central Public Procurement portal is to provide a single point access to the information on procurements made across various Ministries and the Departments.



E-Publishing (GFR - Rule 159): It is mandatory for all Ministries/Departments of the Central Government, their attached and Subordinate Offices and Autonomous /Statutory Bodies, to publish their tender enquiries (including advertised/limited/single tender enquiries), corrigenda thereon and details of bid awards on the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP). E-Publishing has dispensed with print-advertisements in Newspaper etc.

Exemption: Individual cases where confidentiality is required, for reasons of national security, would be exempted from the mandatory e-publishing requirement. These instructions also would not apply to procurements made in terms of Purchase of goods without quotations/ Purchase of goods by purchase committee.

E-Procurement (GFR - Rule 160): It is mandatory for Ministries/ Departments to receive all bids through e-procurement portals in respect of all procurements. Ministries/ Departments which do not have a large volume of procurement or carry out procurements required only for day-to-day running of offices and also have not initiated e-procurement through any other solution provided so far, may use e-procurement solution (CPPP) developed by NIC. Other Ministries/ Departments may either use e-procurement solution developed by NIC or engage any other service provider following due process.

Exemption: In individual case where national

security and strategic considerations demands confidentiality, Ministries/Departments may exempt such cases from e-procurement. Also, Competent Authority may exempt in case of tenders floated by Indian Missions Abroad (global tender).

Advertised /Open Tender Enquiry (GFR - Rule 161): Invitation to tenders by advertisement (open tender) should be given on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) at www.eprocure.gov.in and on GeM. An organisation having its own web site should also publish all its advertised tender enquiries on the web site. The Procuring Entity should also post the complete bidding document in its web site and on CPPP to enable prospective bidders to make use of the document by downloading from the website.

Global Tender enquiry (GTE): as per manual for procurement of goods 2017 is similar to OTE but, through appropriate advertising and provision for payment in Foreign Currencies through Letter of Credit, it is aimed at inviting the participation of inter-alia foreign firms. Advertisement in such cases should be given on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP).

Limited Tender Enquiry (GFR - Rule 162): An organisation should publish its limited tender enquiries on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) as per Rule 159. Apart from CPPP, the organisations should publish the tender enquiries on Department's or Ministry's website.

As per manual for procurement of goods 2017, certain items are procured only from Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) or manufacturers having proprietary rights (or their authorised

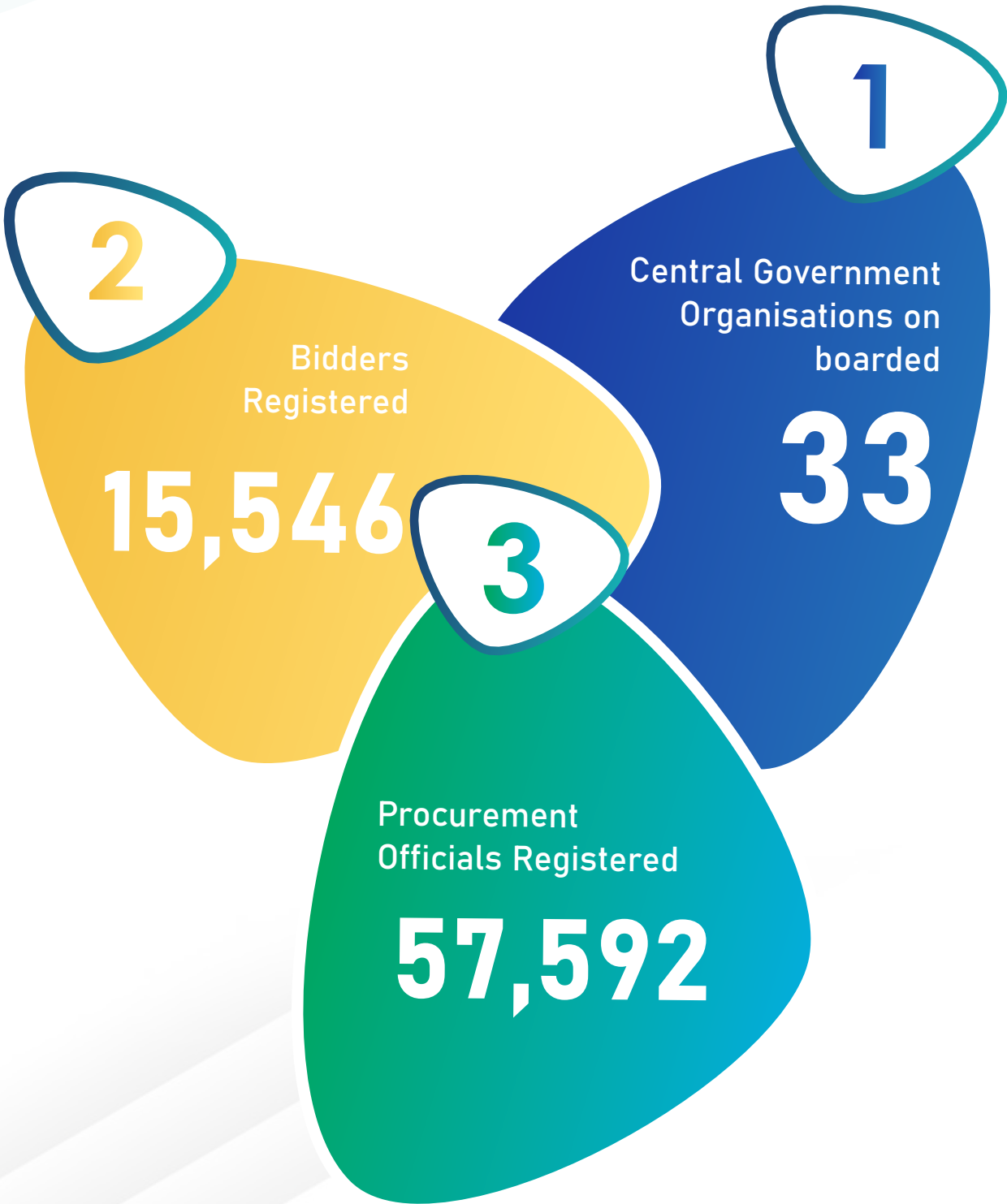
dealers/ stockists) against a Proprietary Article certificate. Even in PAC procurements the NIT and the Award of Contract should be put on the website of CPPP and Procuring Entity.

Transparency, competition, fairness and elimination of arbitrariness in the procurement process (GFR- Rule 173 (xviii): The name of the successful bidder awarded the contract should be mentioned in the CPPP, Ministries or Departments website and their notice board or bulletin.

Identification of likely sources for consulting services (GFR - Rule 183 ii): Where the estimated cost of the consulting services is above Rupees twenty-five lakhs, in addition to Rule 183 (i), an enquiry for seeking 'Expression of Interest ' from consultants should be published on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) at www.eprocure.gov.in and on GeM. An organisation having its own website should also publish all its advertised tender enquiries on the website

Registration of Suppliers (Rule 150): Registration (Simply registering the contractor, without any verification) - All the Ministries/Departments shall register the prospective contractors on their e-procurement portal or in the CPPP (in case they do not have their own e-procurement portal) before submitting their bids.

Major ACTIVITIES IN 2023-2024



NEW FEATURES ADDED

System-Generated AOC Document

Previously, the Tender Accepting Authority (TAA) had to manually upload the AOC document during the contract award process. With this update, the system now generates the AOC document automatically using a predefined template, with an option to upload it manually. The TAA can create the AOC document from the template, ensuring consistency and accuracy. Once generated, the document can be downloaded for verification before finalization and signing, providing additional control and quality assurance. Automating the AOC creation saves time, reduces margin for errors, and maintains consistency in the documents, improving overall efficiency in the contract award process.

Fixed Rate Contract Tenders

A new feature has been introduced in the system for Fixed Rate Contract Tenders. The process involves floating a tender where the rate quoted by eligible suppliers is considered. Suppliers who accept the fixed rate are enlisted by the procuring entity for service or goods delivery on a need basis. The department have to float a tender and the L1/H1 value of financial bids will be received from the bidders. The TIA fixes the applicable rate, and a new tender is floated to obtain acceptance from bidders for the given contract value. In the new tender (fixed rate tender) the TIA uploads the NIT, other required documents if any and BoQ with fixed rate which is protected by the TIA. Participating bidders can only enter their company name in the BoQ, confirming acceptance of the rate.

Market Rate Analysis

A new feature has been introduced to enable the upload of a Market Rate Analysis document for tenders. If the Market Rate Analysis document is enabled, the provision to upload it is available while providing the Technical Evaluation summary. Both PDF and Excel documents are permitted for upload. The link to the uploaded Market Analysis document is then made available on the Financial Opening, Financial Evaluation, and Tender Status pages, ensuring easy access to the document during these stages of the tender process.

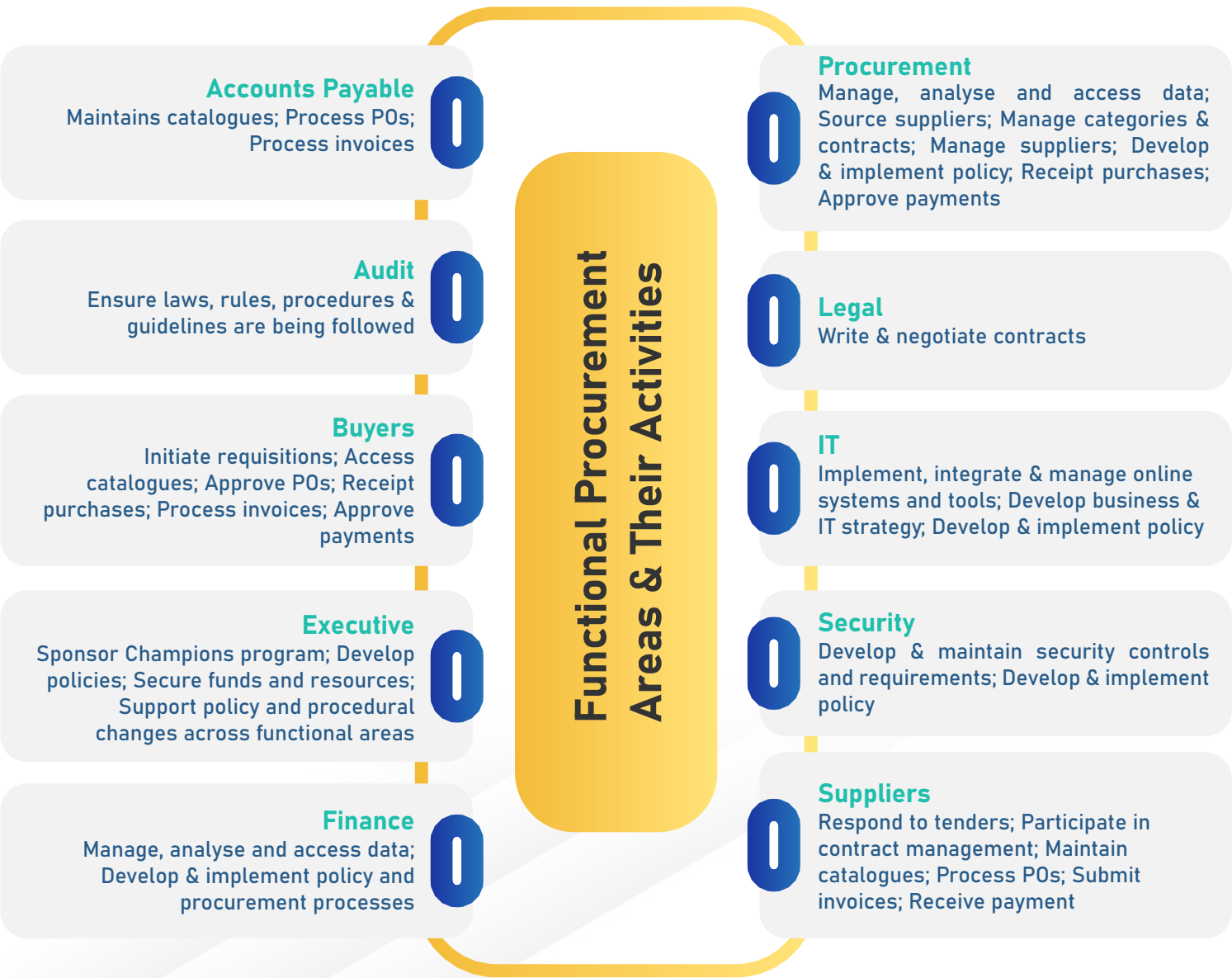

Stakeholder identification

Stakeholders for e-procurement can include any person or functional area that “touches” the systems, tools or information being held. This may include people at all levels of the organisation and external contacts such as suppliers and outsourcing partners. The following list provides a general view of functional procurement areas and their potential e-procurement - related activities.



Managing Stakeholders

When managing suppliers, it is important to demonstrate the benefits of e-procurement as their engagement is critical to success. Communicate what e-procurement can and cannot do followed - up with regular progress reporting and quantifiable metrics. These messages, form part of a strong Communications Plan and will help to keep key stakeholders informed and manage their expectations.

Getting stakeholders to participate can be difficult, especially if they do not understand the value of the implementation to themselves and their functional area. A successful model includes a cross - functional team with members from each functional area (see list detailed in Stakeholder Identification). The team can support testing, development and training activities along with acting as product champions.

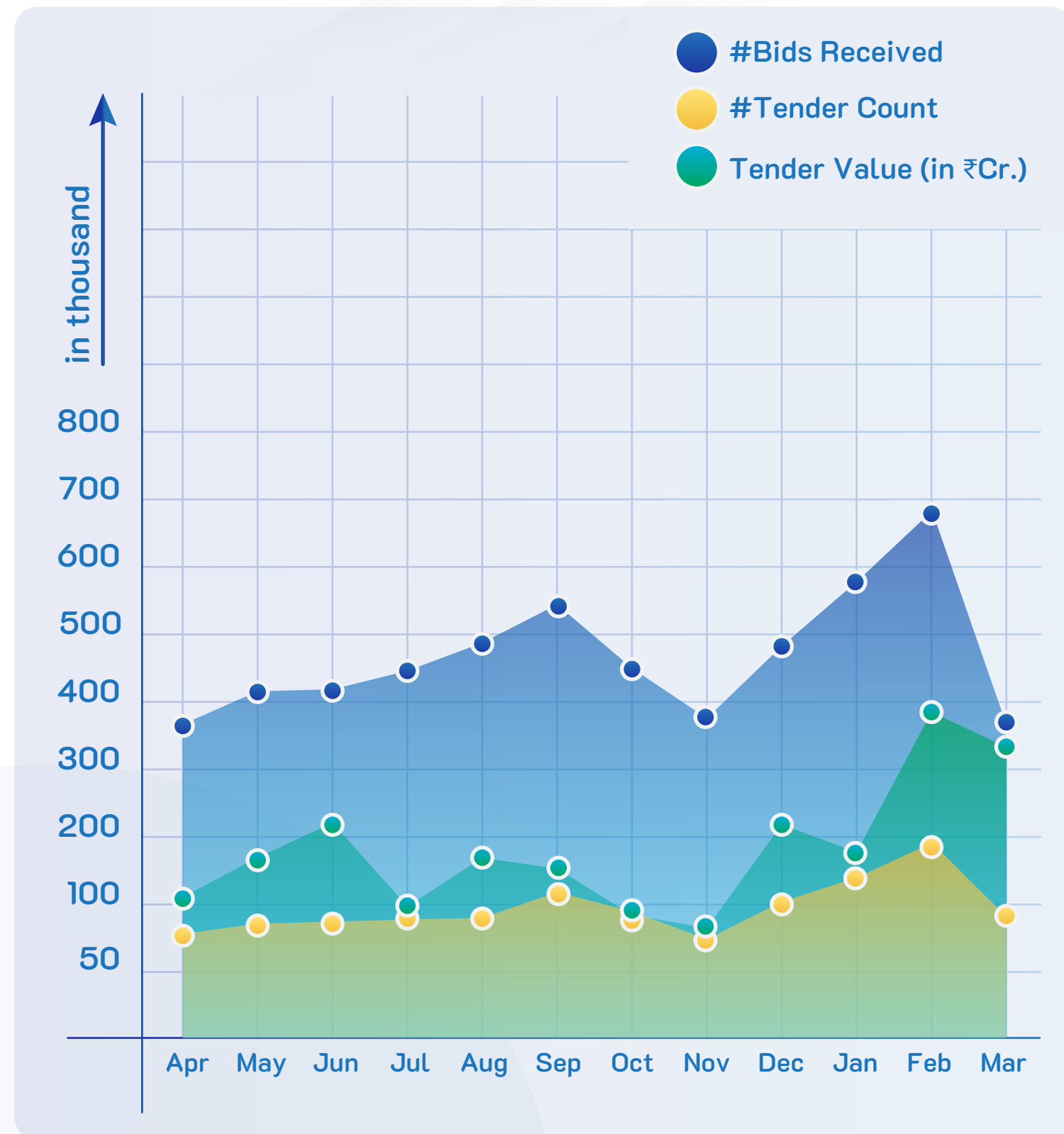
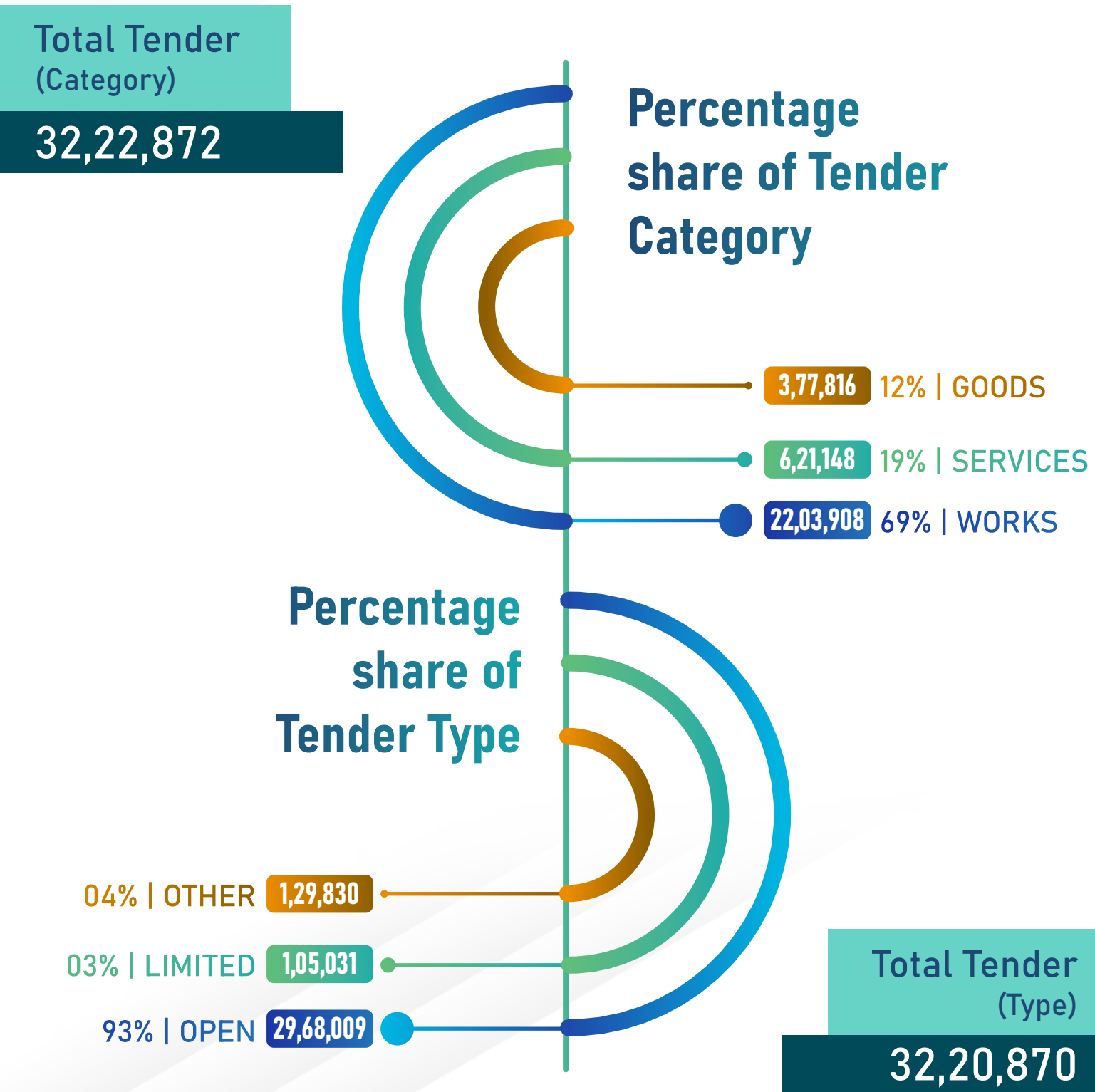

for the Financial Year 2023-24



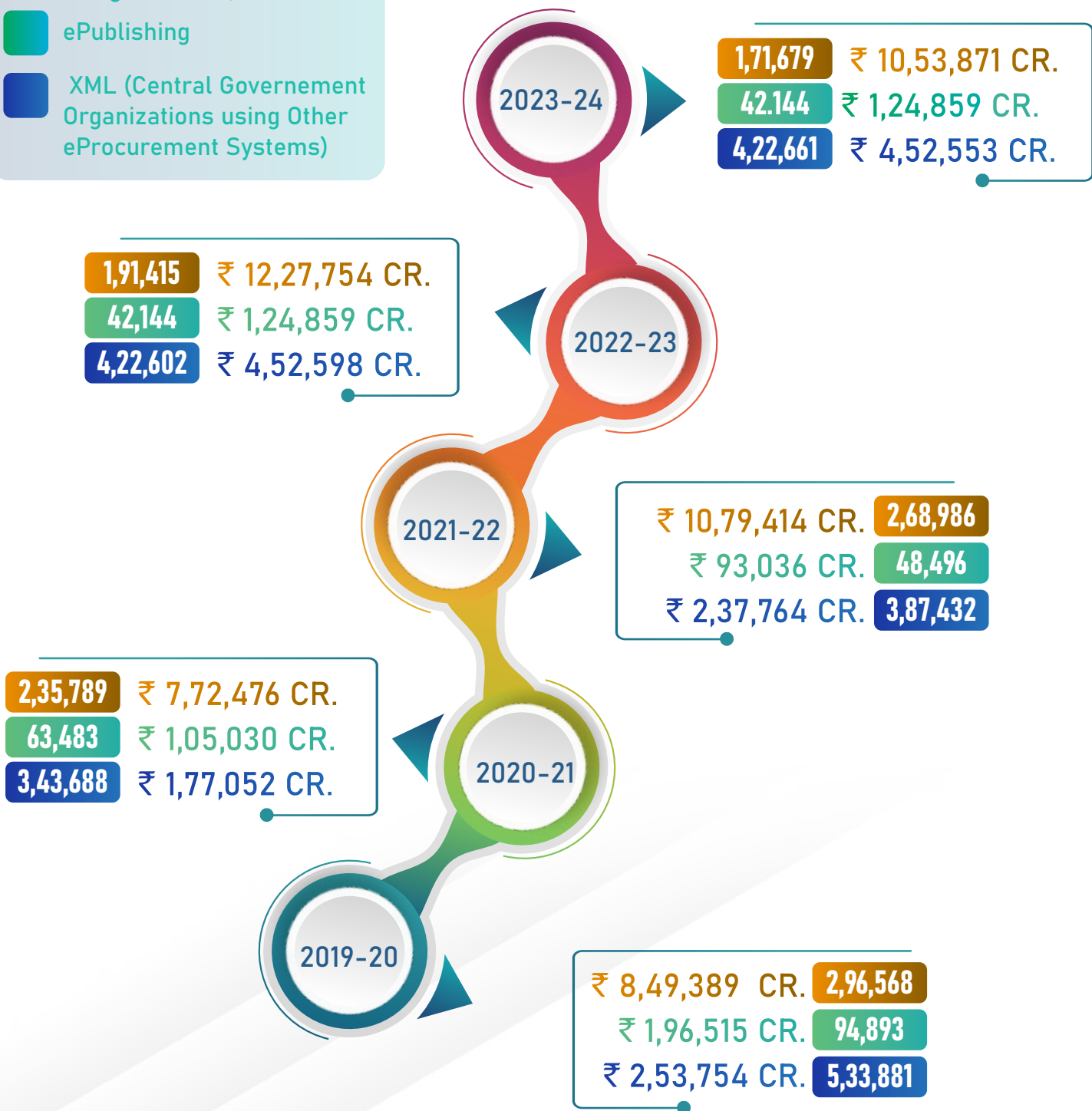

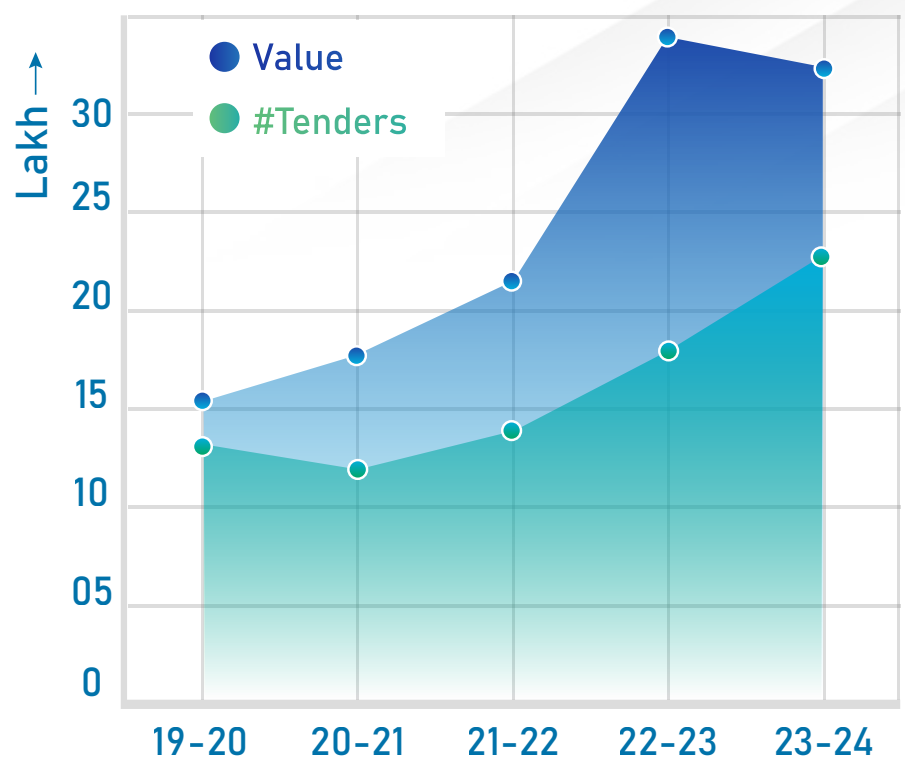

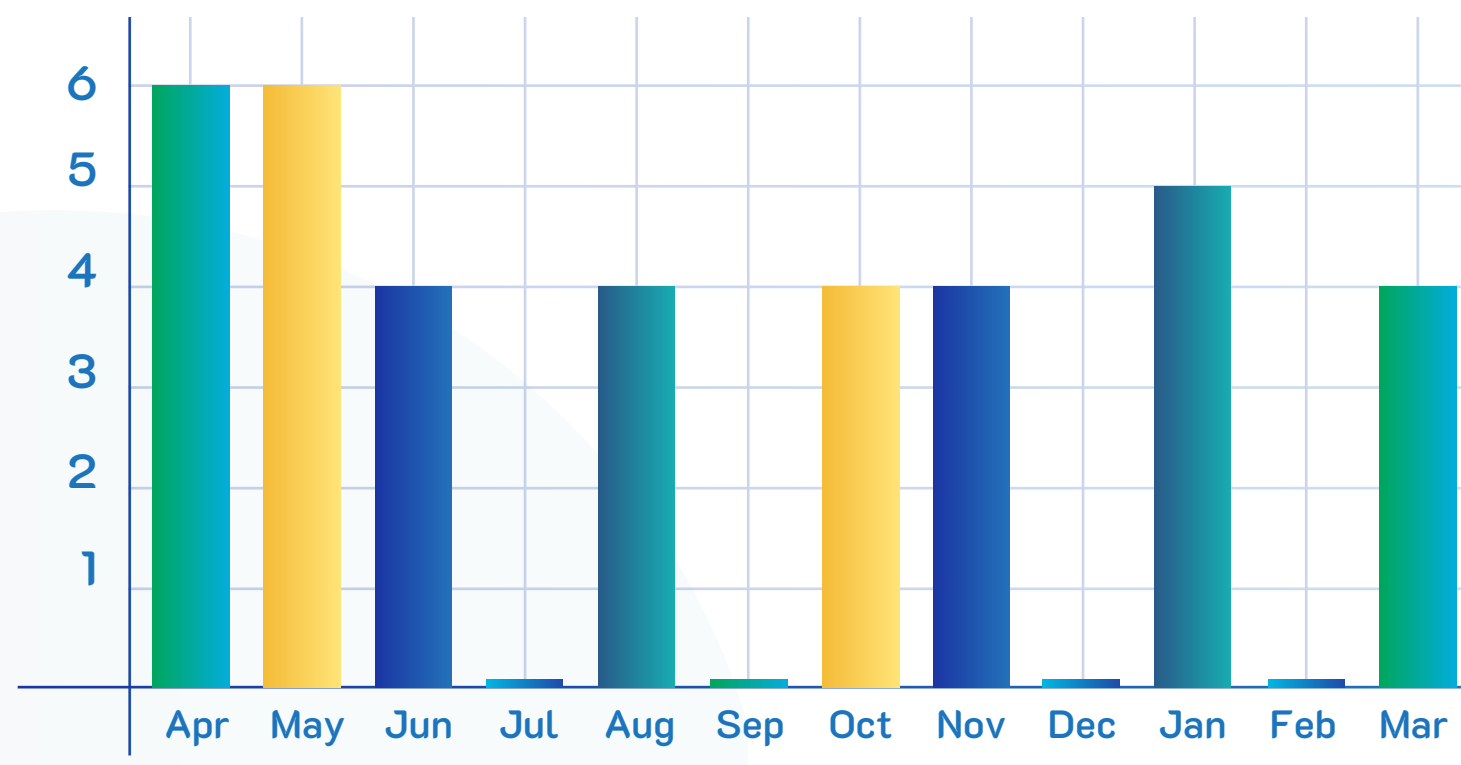

Percentage share of Tenders Floated in Year 2023 - 24

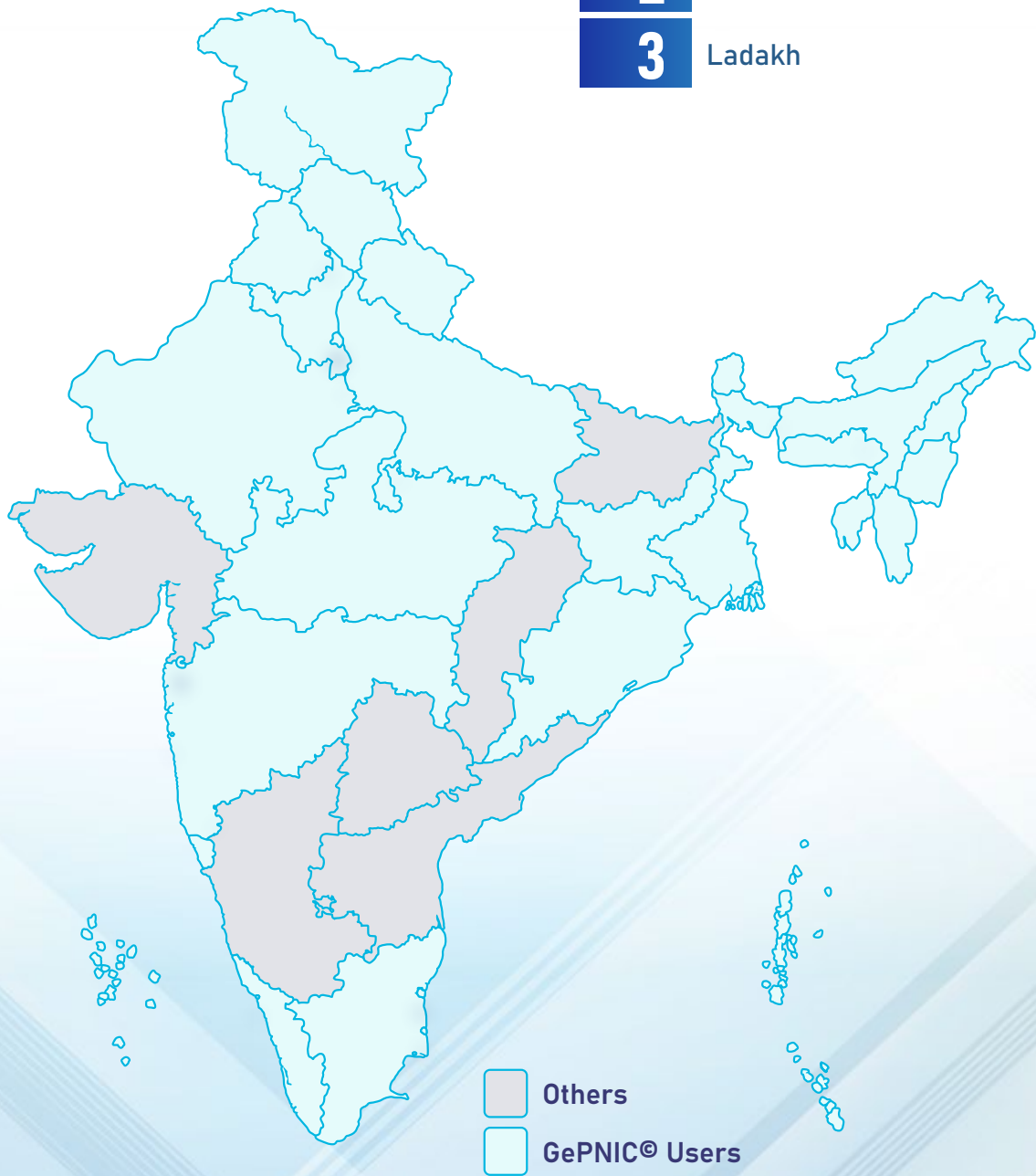

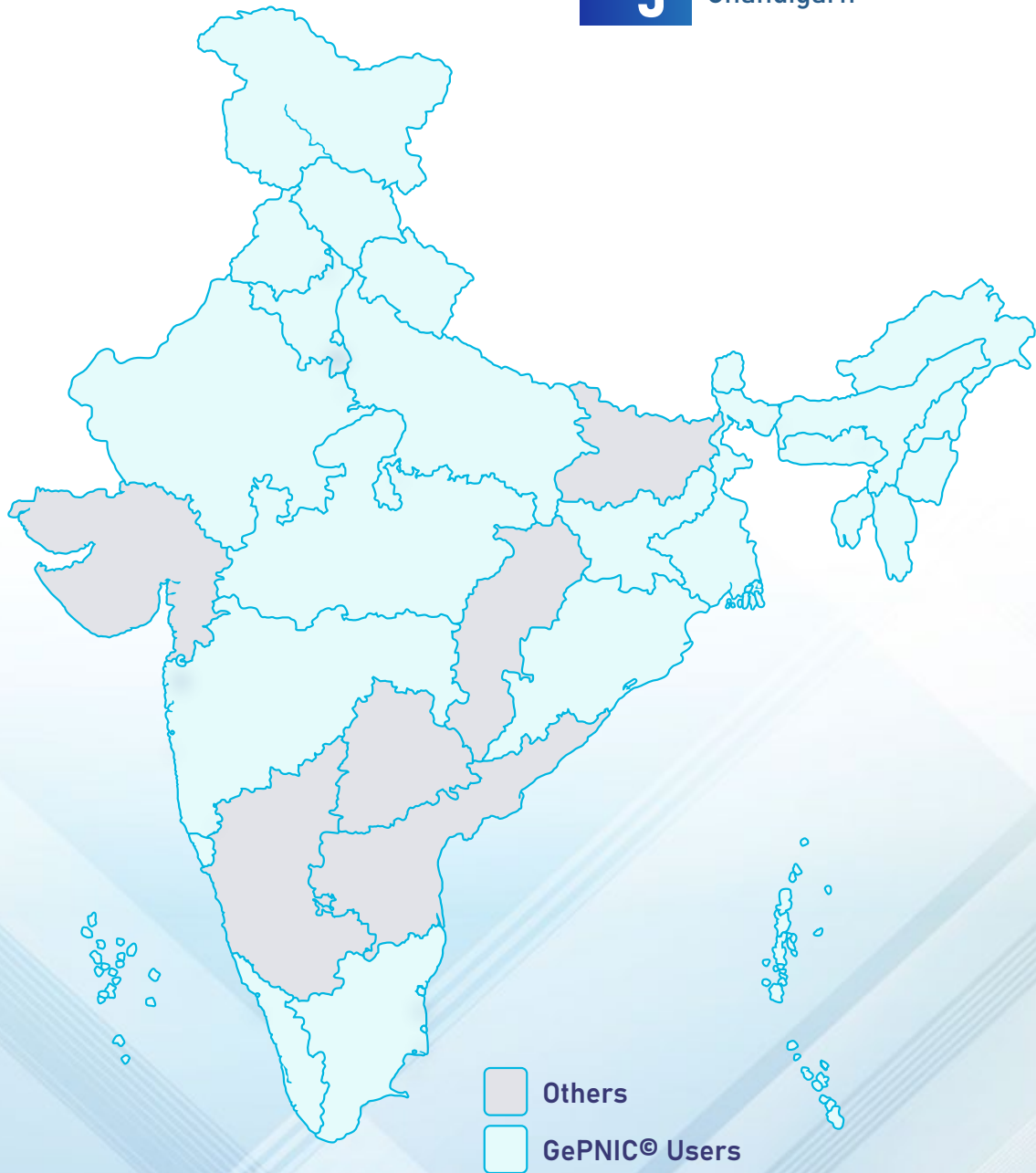

Amendment to General Financial Rules 2017 to include stagewise return of Bid Security / Earnest Money Deposit to bidders in the tendering process dated 1st April 2022 - It has been decided to partially amend Rule 170(ii) of General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 regarding 'Return of Bid Security' as under:

'Bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders should be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 3rd day after the award of the contract'.

However, in case of two packet or two stage bidding, Bid securities of unsuccessful bidders during first stage i.e. technical evaluation etc should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of first stage i.e. technical evaluation etc.

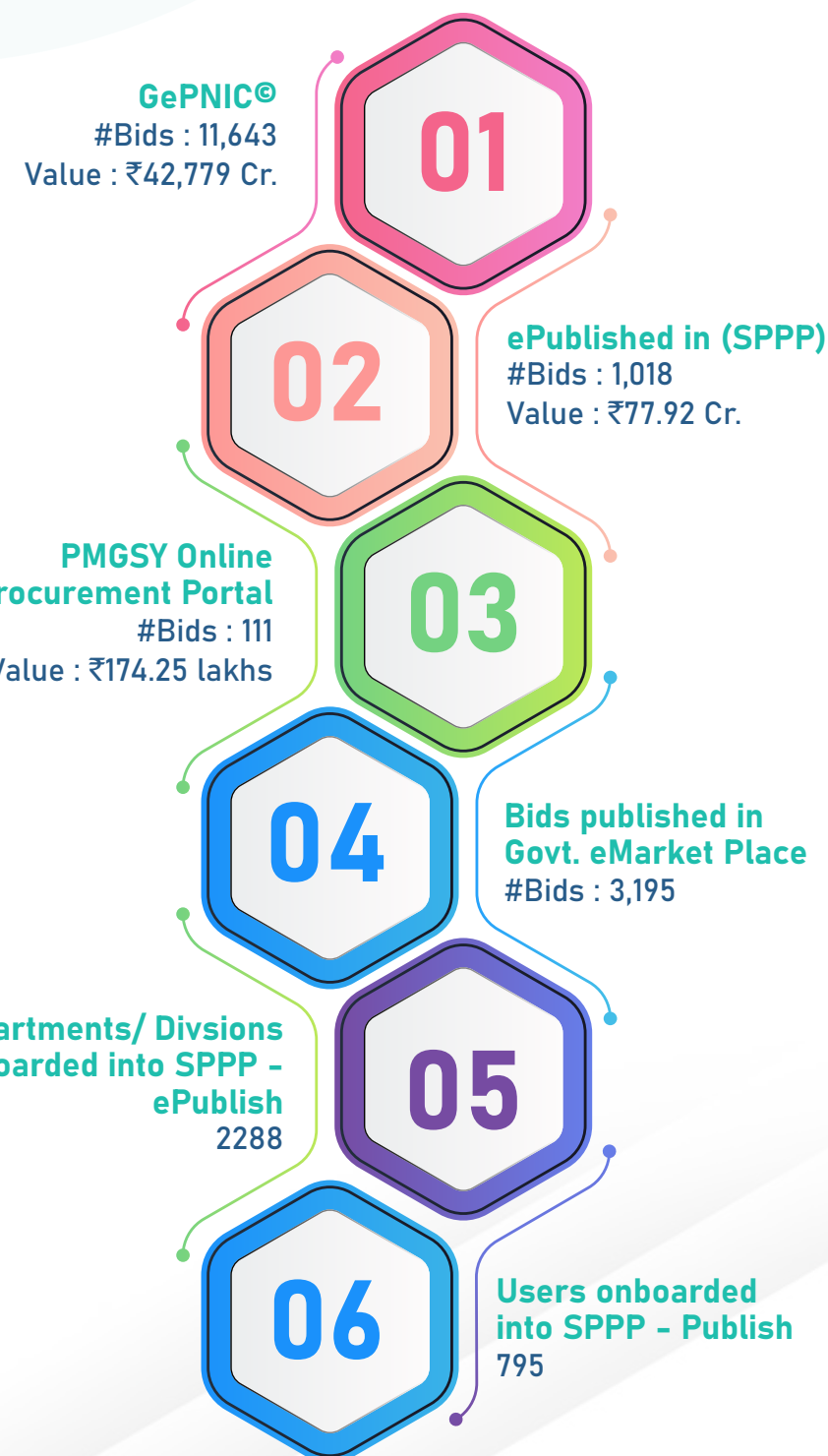
(A) State Public Procurement Portal (SPPP) Government of Assam <https://sppp.assam.gov.in/>

Assam has notified the Assam Public Procurement Act, 2017 and corresponding Rules, 2020 since September, 2021. The State Public Procurement Portal has been set up in pursuance of provisions of Sec. 17 of the Act, 2017. Assam is the second state in the country to come up with such a portal having 'single source of truth' feature.

In order to ensure that complete transparency is made in the public procurement process and to extend the bidders and citizens a single centralised platform for access to any procurement related information, the State Public Procurement Portal (SPPP) has been envisaged.

It is accessible to the general public so that people can have credible information on public procurement of goods, work, and services by the procuring entities.

National Informatics Centre (NIC), an organization of the Government of India under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, has developed the SPP portal of Assam.

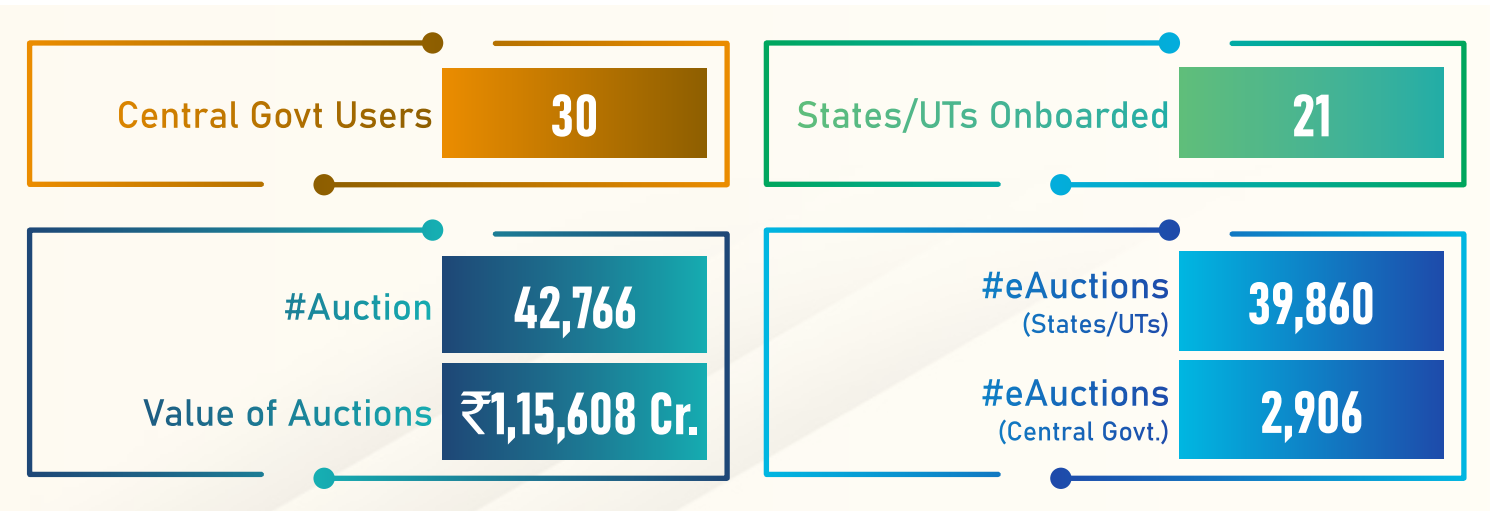

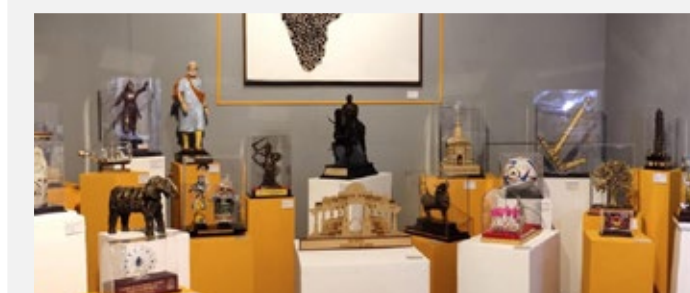

Beyond tendering, CPPP has expanded its footprint through specialized platforms like eAuction India and State Public Procurement Portals, enabling citizen-centric participation and supporting strategic initiatives such as PM Mementos auctions and coal eAuctions. These efforts underscore NIC's commitment to digital transformation and inclusive governance.

As we move forward, the focus will remain on continuous innovation, user-centric enhancements, and integration of emerging technologies to further strengthen India's procurement ecosystem. The journey so far reflects not just technological progress but a collective stride toward a transparent, efficient, and equitable public procurement framework—paving the way for sustainable growth and good governance.
