



About Central Public Procurement Portal

In pursuance of the recommendations of the Committee on Public Procurement headed by Shri Vinod Dhall and the decisions thereon of the Group of Ministers constituted to consider measures to tackle corruption and ensure transparency, the Department of Expenditure has taken action for setting up a Central Public Procurement Portal (CPP Portal in 2012). National Informatics Centre (NIC) has been given the responsibility for setting up this portal.

The primary objective of the portal is to provide a single point access to all the information on procurements made across various Ministries and the line Departments. Tender information from all State/Union Territories,

Central Government entities, Central Public Sector undertakings and Government eMarket Place are made available on a real time basis. The CPP Portal is accessible at the URL http://eprocure.gov.in and it has e-publishing and e-procurement modules.

Active tenders, Corrigendum, Bid Awards, across States/UTs, Central Government, CPSEs, Vendor Debarment information, Global tenders, High value tenders, Grievance/Suggestion capture, Monthly Newsletters, Capacity building programme schedule, are made available.



Background

National Informatics Centre (NIC), Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, in close association with Procurement Policy Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance has developed, hosted and implemented the Central Public Procurement. The core engine behind the CPP Portal is the Government eProcurement system of NIC, GePNIC®.

The system is made available as a platform and can easily be adopted for all kinds of procurement such as Goods, Services & Works. It aims at transparency and non-discrimination amongst bidders, by allowing free access to tender documents, clarifications, secure online bid submission and access to bid opening event to all, from any place on 24x7 basis, using the system through Internet, in a faster, and secure environment adopting industry standard open technologies.

Wide range of procurement requirements of various procuring entities has been built in a robust configurable, workflow-based manner. This can be configured for use by an organization at its apex level, and at multiple subordinate levels, at which tenders could independently be floated.

Strong in-built security features including two-factor Authentication with Digital Signature Certificates (DSCs) for foreign nationals also as per IT Act, Usage of SSL, Role-based User Access and Bidencryption at Client end, using PKI technologies. Security audited by as per EPS guidelines by STQC.

User base across the country by 31 State / Union Territories of India and by more than 614 Central Govt. entities. Processed 70.30 Lakh electronic tender's worth over Rs. 97.30 Lakh Cr. have been processed successfully till 31st March 2021.

Purpose & Audience -

This annual report on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) based on the usage in the year 2021-2022. The year when the world was grappling with COVID 19 Pandemic. The year when everyone witnessed unprecedentedly difficult times specially during the second wave. CPPP team made all efforts to ensure smooth functioning by providing online support, training, hand holding and trouble shooting.

The target audience of this report would be all users of Central Public Procurement Portal, Policy makers, decision makers and other procurement officials or senior management involved in Government procurement. The purpose of the report is to showcase achievements of electronic procurement through CPP Portal across the country by various Central procuring entities, Autonomous Body, State Government, Union Territories and Public Sector Unit(s). This annual report provides information on statistical reports and summarizes and compares statistics with the past year. It shows the trends of

growth, comparative analysis and other variations. Annual report highlights a shortlisted 75 projects executed using the CPP portal by Central Govt, Defense Establishment, States/UTs/CPSEs who have shown tremendous growth. In addition, the functional enhancements made in the portal for benefit of users are also highlighted. A separate section on auctions conducted for Gift items presented to Hon'ble Prime minister is also included.

This report exemplifies the importance of use electronic systems for procurement specially in this era of Global pandemic. As the Central Public Procurement Portal was already widely adopted across India, it was much easier to sail through the lockdown and Work From Home era. In all, we can say that in spite of the disruption for major part of the year procurement worth Rs 17.3 Lakh Crores were accomplished with a cumulative fig of 12.6 Lakh tenders processed in the year April 2020 - Mar 2021 which is almost the same as previous year, if not higher.

Lessons Learnt & Major Challenges

Mission: Develop a secured and reliable end-to-end technological model to ensure not only fair, transparent and cost-effective procurement processes, but also develop, maintain and continuously update a data analytics platform needed to support strategic decisions towards public expenditure reduction and optimization.

Journey so Far

Central Public Procurement Portal was made operational on 1st January, 2012 by providing a two phased model for seamlessly brining in all Central Government entities into electronic procurement ambit - ePublishing and eProcurement.

The seed for GePNIC® was sown way back in 2005-2006 when NIC wanted to adopt online tendering for its own requirements. We, at NIC have modest procurement requirements and process about 100+tenders a year, predominantly of IT equipment and Services. But in a well thought move, in 2005, NIC planned to extend it to other procuring organizations. We experimented with readily available systems provided by third party by customizing it to suit the requirements of government. However, this exercise couldn't be sustained. That's when we realized that if we need to serve various government departments, we would need to carve out a solution of our own i.e., we needed to be Atmanirbhar.

NIC took up the challenge to provide an ecosystem which could emulate the complete existing procurement process without any compromise on procedures and practices followed, but by bringing in re-engineered process with more security, enhanced transparency and undoubted authenticity. Thus, was born a generic e-Procurement software system, viz. Government eProcurement System of National Informatics Centre, GePNIC®. It was developed in house to cater to the procurement / tendering requirements of the Government departments and organizations. The system can easily be adopted for all kinds of procurement activities such as Goods, Services & Works.

From around 11,000 tenders worth Rs. 20,000 Crores per year in 2009 - 2010, GePNIC® graduated to process 12.6 Lakh tenders worth Rs. 17.3 Lakh crores per year in 2020-2021. CPP portal brought about phenomenal transformation by facilitating adoption of Online procurement across the country, wide and deep.

By issuing various guidelines and with constant monitoring, Procurement Policy Division, Department of Expenditure has successfully on boarded majority of Central government procuring entities on to the portal. Multiple channels of Capacity Building, Easy availability of Digital Signature Certificates, Process re-engineering as per need, inculcating the adoption of Best Practices across organization, availability of uniform platform for ease of use and quick adoption in case of interdepartmental transfers etc. were the steps taken which resulted in multifold increase growth over the last few years across the country.

Central Public Procurement Portal

As per Government Finance Rules (GFR 2017) The Transparency Principle which is one of the fundamental principles of public procurement as per General Financial Rules, 2017 (Rule 144) states that 'all procuring entities should ensure that offers should be invited following a fair and transparent procedure and also ensure publication of all relevant information on the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP).

Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) has been designed, developed and hosted by National Informatics Centre (NIC, Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology) in association with Dept. of Expenditure to ensure transparency in the public procurement process. The primary objective of the Central Public Procurement portal is to provide a single point access to the information on procurements made across various Ministries and the Departments.

ePublishing (GFR - Rule 159)

It is mandatory for all Ministries/Departments of the Central Government, their attached and Subordinate Offices and Autonomous/Statutory Bodies, to publish their tender enquiries (including advertised/limited/single tender enquiries), corrigenda thereon and details of bid awards on the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP). E-Publishing has dispensed with print-advertisements in Newspaper etc.

Exemption: Individual cases where confidentiality is required, for reasons of national security, would be exempted from the mandatory e-publishing requirement. These instructions also would not apply to procurements made in terms of Purchase of goods without quotations/ Purchase of goods by purchase committee.

Advertised /Open Tender Enquiry (GFR - Rule 161)

Invitation to tenders by advertisement (open tender)should be given on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) at www.eprocure. gov.in and on GeM. An organisation having its own web site should also publish all its advertised tender enquiries on the web site. The Procuring Entity should also post the complete bidding document in its web site and on CPPP to enable prospective bidders to make use of the document by downloading from the website.

eProcurement (GFR - Rule 160)

It is mandatory for Ministries/ Departments to receive all bids through e-procurement portals in respect of all procurements. Ministries/ Departments which do not have a large volume of procurement or carry out procurements required only for day-to-day running of offices and also have not initiated e-procurement through any other solution provided so far, may use e-procurement solution (CPPP) developed by NIC. Other Ministries/ Departments may either use e-procurement solution developed by NIC or engage any other service provider following due process.

Exemption: In individual case where national security and strategic considerations demands confidentiality, Ministries/ Departments may exempt such cases from e-procurement. Also, Competent Authority may exempt in case of tenders floated by Indian Missions Abroad (global tender).

Registration of Suppliers (Rule 150)

Registration (Simply registering the contractor, without any verification)-All the Ministries/
Departments shall register the prospective contractors on their e-procurement portal or in the CPPP (in case they do not have their own e-procurement portal) before submitting their bids.

Transparency, competition, fairness and elimination of arbitrariness in the procurement process (GFR-Rule 173 (xviii)

The name of the successful bidder awarded the contract should be mentioned in the CPPP, Ministries or Departments website and their notice board or bulletin.

Limited Tender Enquiry (GFR - Rule 162)

An organisation should publish its limited tender enquiries on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) as per Rule 159. Apart from CPPP, the organisations should publish the tender enquiries on Department's or Ministry's website.

As per manual for procurement of goods 2017, certain items are procured only from Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) or manufacturers having proprietary rights (or their authorised dealers/ stockists) against a Proprietary Article certificate. Even in PAC procurements the NIT and the Award of Contract should be put on the website of CPPP and Procuring Entity.

Identification of likely sources for consulting services (GFR - Rule 183 ii)

Where the estimated cost of the consulting services is above Rupees twenty-five lakhs, in addition to Rule 183 (i), an enquiry for seeking 'Expression of Interest' from consultants should be published on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) at www.eprocure.gov.in and on GeM. An organisation having its own website should also publish all its advertised tender enquiries on the website.

Global Tender enquiry (GTE)

As per manual for procurement of goods 2017 is similar to OTE but, through appropriate advertising and provision for payment in Foreign Currencies through Letter of Credit, it is aimed at inviting the participation of interalia foreign firms. Advertisement in such cases should be given on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP).

Corrigendum for extension of Financial Bid Opening Date and Time

At the time of Technical Evaluation, Dept user specifies the Date and Time for opening of Financial Cover. Due to any reasons, if Dept needs to extend the Financial Bid Opening Date and Time on the portal, a corrigendum is made available for the same. Department can make use of the same and specify the revised Financial Bid Opening Date and Time for their tender.



Letter of Acceptance / Letter of Intent

A provision has been made in the system regarding asking the Letter of Acceptance from the Bidder to whom the tender needs to be awarded. In this, after Financial Evaluation, Department User selects the bidder for AOC and request for the consent by sending Letter of Intent to concerned Bidder and bidder gives the consent by providing signed Letter of Acceptance to the Department, then Department user can complete the process of Award of Contract on the portal.

Resubmission of Shortfall Document by Bidder

Tender Inviting Authority may ask the Short fall document during technical evaluation stage. Technical Evaluator can ask the shortfall document from the participated bidders. Only the document which was asked in the technical cover content during tender creation can be asked as short fall document from the bidder. Now, the provision has been made for Resubmission of Shortfall documents. Once the Bidder has submitted the shortfall documents, if required Dept can ask for resubmission mentioning the reason along with document submission end date and time.

Tender cum Auction Flow

A new version of Tender cum Auction flow has been enabled in the system, the Auction will be initiated before Financial Opening of the tender, and after completion of Auction, Financial Opening will be done and system will provide the Comparative chart indicating the rates submitted by bidders in Individual BOQs and also the rates mentioned during Auction Process. If the above Tender cum Auction process suits any Procuring Entity requirement, then the same can be adopted by selecting "Yes" for option New Tender cum Auction flow required in Work Item Details during Tender creation on the portal.




Managing Stakeholders

















Percentage Share of Procurement Spend of 31 States & UTs using GePNIC[®] (~ ₹ 21.28 Lakh Crores)




Percentage of Bidders across India of 31 States & UTs using GePNIC[®] (~ 3.9 Lakh Bidders)



GePNIC[®] month - wise breakup for the Financial Year 2021-22





















Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance has issued an OM No.F.1/2/2022-PPD dated 1st April, 2022. It has been decided to partially amend Rule 170(ii) of General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 regarding 'Return of Bid Security' as under:

'Bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders should be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 3dh day after the award of the contract'.

However, in case of two packet or two stage bidding, Bid securities of unsuccessful bidders during first stage i.e. technical evaluation etc should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of first stage i.e. technical evaluation etc.





In addition to brining in all the tender enquiries, corrigendum information, CPP portal hosts all the Office Memorandums / Office orders / Policy / Guidelines / Procurement Manuals / CVC guidelines related to procurement, thus making it a one stop shop for any procurement related information.

In addition to core electronic tendering work NIC has also taken up many bespoke requirements like development of workflow-based system for Crude Oil Procurement, Design and development of platform for Coal Auction, enhanced features for Open auction. The Vendor registration module for Coal Auction has gone live and work in progress for completion of rest. Dashboard has been enhanced to provide more insight into the procurement process with more KPIs and drill down reports.

To commemorate with the 75th year of Independence we are observing Azadi ka Amrith Mahotsav across the country. In tune with the national spirit, we have also picked up 75 key projects executed through Government eProcurement system of NIC, GePNIC which includes facilitates all kinds of procurement like turnkey projects, Civil and consultancy works, Public Private Partnership etc. Due care has been taken to represent at least one project from all States/ UTs and major Central Govt entities using GePNIC[®].

The average tenders processed per month is around 1.19 lakh worth Rs 1.77 Lakhs crores in this financial year. The overall tenders for 2021-22 is 14,24,276 worth Rs 21,28,413 Crore and the total procurement carried out since inception is 84,55,283 tenders worth Rs 1,18,61,331 Crore. There is a foot fall of 3,90,000 Vendors/ Suppliers 4,25,679 Department User across the country for this platform.
